Subject Application of the Multi-Track Development Process to FOS

Description of Problem or Suggestion:

It is not clear from the FOS PDR presentation or supporting documentation how the multi-track development approach will be applied to FOS.

Originator's Recommendation

Define how Flight Operations Segment development will be allocated to the incremental and formal development tracks. The Release Plan Content Description (FB9403V4) states that flight operations is a candidate for formal development. It also states that some candidate components for formal development may need to be developed incrementally to support the infrastructure of other components that are being developed incrementally. Identify the FOS components, if any, that fall into this category.
